Rural Rocks Side Trail

The Bruce Trail Side Trail

Rural Roots is the first property in Ontario with a conservation easement and an integrated trail system. The official Bruce Trail loop trail is called Rural Rocks Side Trail on their official maps.

Here you will see the best of the entire length of the Bruce Trail in two hours. Along the south of the property the trail leads through magnificent crevice caves. It continues past a

10 acre beaver pond, over a boardwalk and enters a deep woods along the north boundary of the property.

Another boardwalk goes along the top of an actual beaver dam. Along the east boundary the terrain opens up to view the cliffs of Skinner's Bluff before returning to the parking lot.

The trail is accessed just off county road #13 where there is ample off road parking. This is a loop trail which intersects an internal trail system. Please follow the painted blue blazes which designate the Bruce Trail side trail.

The trail is open 24-7 to the public.

The Internal Trail Systems

There are two different sets of trails on this property, both of them developed by Ken Ingham, long time friend and mentor to us at Rural Roots. The internal system consists of a number of short "stem and loop" trails. Each features a prominent element of the property. They range in length from 15 min. to $\frac{3}{4}$ of an hour and all radiate from the house. There is no charge for enjoying these trails and we will even provide a walking stick should you wish to use one!

The internal trails are only open to the public during regular business hours.
